I wanted to confirm whether you had any updated TPs on Empowerment you are able to share with us. In particular, we are seeking language related to post-referendum next steps, including on the Uluru Statement from the Heart.

For your visibility, below is the language we're currently using, based on NIAA's Standard Words from late 2023. We welcome any edits/additions you have to this proposed response.

Is the Government still committed to implementation of the Uluru Statement from the Heart, including truth-telling agreement-making?

- The Government is considering next steps following the referendum and will continue to listen to and work with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people going forward.
The Uluru Statement from the Heart called for a Voice enshrined in the Constitution. On 14 October 2023, the Government fulfilled its promise to hold a referendum to recognise the First Peoples of Australia in the Constitution by establishing a Voice. The Government made a commitment to implement the Uluru Statement from the Heart, which called for a Voice enshrined in the Constitution.
The referendum did not pass. The Government respects the decision of the Australian people.
In the October 2022-23 Budget, the Government committed \$5.8 billion over three (3) years to commence work on a Makarrata Commission to oversee processes for agreement making and truth telling.
NIAA is best placed to answer questions related to the establishment of a Makarrata Commission.
