Low aromatic unleaded fuel can be used in any engine in which manufacturers recommend the use of regular unleaded 91 fuel. This includes cars, boats and small engines such as lawn mowers, whipper snippers, generators, chainsaws, bikes and all-terrain vehicles.

Low aromatic unleaded fuel has extremely low levels of aromatics making it less attractive for people to sniff in order to get 'high'.

Cost

The Australian Government funds the extra costs of producing low aromatic unleaded fuel. This allows it to be sold at a similiar price to regular unleaded fuel. When you fill up using low aromatic unleaded fuel it should not cost you more, but it will make a big difference to the local community.
